









































### Khazar University Sustainable Development Goals Summary

### Mission

The mission of Khazar University is to serve Azerbaijan and the broader region through an exceptional university education in undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate levels of studies with a student-centered approach as the main pillar. The university has a strong commitment to continuously evaluate, develop and improve academic activities and to enhance theoretical and applied research that benefits the country and society as a whole.

### Vision

The vision of the University is to become a world-class higher education institution, recognized for its excellence in education and research, as well as wide-ranging partnerships with stakeholders both nationally and internationally.

### **SDG 1 No Poverty**

Khazar University is dedicated to contributing to the Millennium Development Goal on "eradicating extreme hunger and poverty". The University is committed to ensuring that financial issues do not present an obstacle for students. In

addition to merit-based scholarships based on the points gained at the Entrance Exams, Khazar University provides need-based scholarships:

- in case if one or both parents work at Khazar University
- in case if 2 (two) or more students from one family are studying at Khazar University
- students from the Martyr family
- students from the families of disabled from the Karabagh war
- in case of the loss of both parents
- if a student has lost one of his / her parents while studying

Khazar University supports students with excellent academic performance from all over the world to study at Khazar University. "Excellence scholarship" covers the full tuition fee of international students, enabling them to study tuition-free at Khazar University. Merit scholarship covers cover 75%, 50%, or 25% of the tuition fee. Meanwhile, University provides successful master and PhD students with an opportunity to teach and earn monthly salary to cover their basic needs.

All students from low-income countries enrolled to Khazar University in year 2019 received university's scholarship.



### SDG 3 Good Health and Wellbeing

### The third symposium on World One Health Day

Khazar University's Department of Life Sciences held the 3<sup>rd</sup> symposium on World One Health Day. Specialists of various

public and private institutions of Azerbaijan, scholars of the scientific institutions made presentations at the symposium.

The main aim of the symposium was to promote understanding of the importance of One Health, exchange data and knowledge to recognize and improve human, animal and ecosystem health issues in Azerbaijan and around the globe.

### Awareness raising and behavioural development for reproductive health of the youth and family planning

A number of workshops "Awareness raising and behavioural development for reproductive health of the youth and family planning" were held for students at Khazar University.

This awareness raising workshops were organized within "Action Plan of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Azerbaijan on implementation of the Azerbaijani Youth State Program 2017-2021", approved by Order #72 of the Ministry of Health. For this purpose, awareness raising campaigns on "Reproductive health and healthy lifestyle - family planning" are conducted by experts at universities and colleges.



### **SDG 4 Quality Education**

### **Contribution through aligned courses**

A review of the university's courses revealed that more than 60 % of courses have coverage of sustainable development, social responsibility, or impact on the community.

### **Contribution to Economic and Business Education**

Within the framework of BP-Azerbaijan's support for education, a world-renowned textbook by "Pearson" Publishing House entitled "Macroeconomics" was translated into Azerbaijani by a team of Khazar University.

This textbook, translated into Azerbaijani for the first time, is intended for use by students majoring in economics and management, teachers, start-up entrepreneurs, managers, and the public.

### **Launch of Data Science Program**

Khazar University was signing a new initiative being first in Azerbaijan. Regarded as one of the most exciting professions of the 21st Century - **Data Science**, a one-year education program, was launched at the University.

The curriculum, developed by professional teachers with international experience, will help each student acquire the necessary and basic knowledge in the field of Data Science by collecting all the necessary information in this field, and further apply this knowledge in practice.

### **Khazar University in THE University Impact Rankings 2019**

Khazar University is the only University in Azerbaijan ranked 301+ in the world under SDG 4 'Quality Education' and 201-300 in SDG9 'Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure'.



### SDG 7 Affordable and Clean Energy

### 1st International Conference on "Air-Land-Sea Interactions"

Khazar University hosted an International Conference entitled "Air-Land-Sea Interactions". The conference was organized jointly by UNESCO, Khazar University, Istanbul

Aydın University, Istanbul Technical University, Chinese Academy of Sciences, and Eurasian Universities Union (EURAS).

Participants discussed such topics as alternative energy sources, environmental pollution, atmospheric events, human impact on the environment, climate change, drought, and dangerous nature events.

### SDG 8 Decent Work and Economic Growth

### Curriculum

Khazar University is dedicated to policy-oriented research and trainings promoting social responsibility, sustainable value of business and society, global leadership, mutual partnership to solve sustainable

development challenges.

More than 80% of courses of the School of Economics and Management have include Principles of Responsible Management Education that are disseminated across the university.

### Research

Analysis of research outcomes revealed that Khazar University researchers produced about 10% of research outputs linked to Goal 8.

Researches focus on resource-rich countries' development models, macroeconomic policy framework for oil-rich countries, resource curse, economic diversification, poverty reduction, migration and sustainable development.

### "Made in Azerbaijan 2019" Competition

The aim of the competition, organized jointly by the Ministry of Education of Azerbaijan Republic, Ministry of Youth and Sports, "Kapital Bank" OJSC and Azerbaijan

State Economic University, is to promote entrepreneurship among students.

Over 40 projects from country's various universities were presented to "Made in Azerbaijan 2019" business idea-competition. Expert Council have evaluated business ideas and consequently five projects made it to the final. "One click-one hand team", established by Aydin Salimli, 3rd year student of Khazar University's Economics and Management School (majoring in tourism and hospitality, and Javidan Alizade, 3rd year student of the Azerbaijan State Economic University's Finance Faculty, are amongst the five finalist teams.

### **Creative Spark Partnership Fund 2019**

Khazar University in partnership with Middlesex University Higher Education Corporation, UK is one of the winners of Creative Spark Partnership Fund 2019 supported by the British Council. This partnership enables students to develop their entrepreneurship skills.

The School of Economics and Management at Khazar University contributes to the success of the project by providing courses on Entrepreneurship that include the development of entrepreneurial, leadership and managerial skills.



### **Goal 10 Reduced Inequalities**

"Integration of People with Disabilities into Society" event

Khazar University hosted an event entitled "Integration of People with Disabilities into Society" organized by the

Department of Psychology. The role of the media outlets in integration of the people with disabilities, practical use of foreign models, current problems and reforms in Azerbaijan and other topics were discussed.
