Nailekhanim Foundation Scholarship

In 2022, the Nailekhanim Foundation offered a prestigious, competition-based full scholarship to a gifted female student, irrespective of their national background and citizenship.

Additionally, Khazar University provides the following need-based scholarships:

- For cases where one or both parents work at Khazar University.
- For situations where two or more students from a single family are studying at Khazar University.
- Scholarships for students from Martyr families.
- Scholarships for students from families affected by disabilities due to the Karabagh war.
- In the event of the loss of both parents.
- If a student has lost one of their parents while pursuing their studies.

Khazar University supports students with outstanding academic performance from around the world, enabling them to pursue their studies at the university through various scholarship programs. The 'Excellence Scholarship' covers the full tuition fee for international students, allowing them to study at Khazar University tuition-free. The 'Merit Scholarship' provides coverage of 75%, 50%, or 25% of the tuition fee, based on the level of achievement. Additionally, the University offers successful master's and Ph.D. students the opportunity to teach and earn a monthly salary to support their basic needs.

In the year 2022, all students from low-income countries enrolled at Khazar University received a university scholarship.

Khazar University is dedicated to SDG2, Zero Hunger, with a commitment to ending hunger, ensuring food security, improving nutrition, and promoting sustainable agriculture.

2nd International Congress on Cocoa Coffee and Tea Asia

On May 19-20, 2022, the 2nd International Congress on Cocoa Coffee and Tea Asia was held at Khazar University. The Congress was conducted along with the cooperation and partnership agreement on scientific research projects between of the Anhui Agricultural University, and the State Key Lab of Tea Plant Biology and Utilization which are the world leaders in tea science and education.

Khazar University is dedicated to advancing SDG3 through a multidisciplinary approach. The university is committed to generating value in the field of healthcare by producing scientific advancements, offering innovative solutions, and disseminating knowledge.

Research Collaboration

In 2022, Khazar University's Psychology Department initiated a collaboration with the University of Silesia in Katowice, Poland, and the University of Gdansk, Poland, formalizing this partnership by signing a research collaboration agreement. Together, they are conducting a joint research project that delves into the influence of macro-, meso-, and micro-level factors on work addiction and the resultant health-related challenges.

Health and Pollution Action Plan

On May 6, 2022, the Global Alliance on Health and Pollution convened to deliberate on the Health and Pollution Action Plan, which was coordinated by Khazar University's Department of Geography and the Environment.

During the event, the primary pollution challenges in Azerbaijan were addressed, and collaborative solutions were explored. A representative from the GAHP presented clean-up projects proposed to tackle these issues.

Awareness raising and behavioral development for the reproductive health of the youth and family planning

A series of workshops entitled "Awareness and Behavioral Development for Youth Reproductive Health and Family Planning" were organized for Khazar University students. Expert-led awareness campaigns on "Reproductive Health and Healthy Lifestyles, with a focus on Family Planning," are regularly conducted.



Quality Education

As an integral part of its dedication to the Sustainable Development Goals, Khazar University is firmly committed to providing high-quality, inclusive, and equitable education.

Khazar University is committed to sustainable development through the following actions:

- Integration of sustainable development issues into university curricula.

- Updating the themes of student theses, master's theses, and Ph.D. theses across all schools to include sustainable development.

- Developing open online courses on sustainable development and promoting them within the local community via university Moodle platform.

Research

Rovshan Abbasov, who serves as the Head of the Geography and Environment Department at Khazar University, played a pivotal role as a key speaker during the second panel on "Wastewater Management, Recycling, and Environmental Impacts" of Baku Water Innovation Forum.

This event aimed to raise public awareness and support for the transition to 100% renewable energy beyond the university's boundaries.

Ultimately, the companies and the university reached a mutual agreement, solidifying their commitment to ongoing collaboration in achieving 100% renewable energy usage.


Natural Resources for Sustainable Development multi-mode course 2022

The Eurasia Extractive Industries Knowledge Hub offered the "Natural Resources for Sustainable Development" course in 2022, that was designed as a multi-mode program. This comprehensive course offered a strong foundation in theories and practices essential for effective resource governance. It comprised both online and

residential components, culminating in a final assignment in the form of a research or analytical paper.

In addition to modules covering data analysis, revenue management, and contracting, participants in the online phase had the valuable opportunity to engage in discussions with experts from the Eurasia Hub.

The program's overarching goal is to foster a robust dialogue about global best practices and their applicability to countries in the region, thereby promoting valuable lessons and insights for sustainable development.

Khazar University is committed to conducting policyoriented research and training that promotes social responsibility, the sustainable value of business and society, global leadership, and fostering mutual

partnerships to address sustainable development challenges.

Curriculum

Notably, over 80% of the courses offered by the School of Economics and Management incorporate Principles of Responsible Management Education, which are actively disseminated throughout the university.

Research Output

Analysis of research outcomes indicates that Khazar University researchers contributed to approximately 15% of research outputs associated with Goal 8. The research primarily focuses on the development models of resource-rich countries, macroeconomic policy frameworks for oil-rich nations, resource curse phenomena, economic diversification, poverty reduction, migration, and sustainable development.

Bootcamp "72 hours of a mentor"

Creative Spark Partnership Fund

Khazar University in partnership with Middlesex University, UK is one of the winners of the Creative Spark Partnership Fund supported by the British Council. This partnership enables students to develop their entrepreneurship skills.

In 2022, Khazar University, in partnership with Middlesex University, UK, organized a series of trainings for young entrepreneurs with the support of the British Council's Creative Spark Higher Education Enterprise Program.

Khazar University Climate Action Plan

On January 19, 2022, the Department of Geography and Environment hosted a presentation ceremony for the updated "Khazar University Climate Action Plan". The event saw participation from over 30 representatives of diverse organizations, including the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources, the Ministry of Emergency Situations, various NGOs, and academia. It is worth mentioning that the Khazar University Climate Action Plan was initially developed in 2015 and has been consistently updated.

Conference of Assuming Responsibility for Climate Change Project (arCc)

On April 25, 2022, the concluding conference of the 'Assuming Responsibility for Climate Change' (arCc) project, organized by Khazar University in collaboration with Middlesex University, took place. This virtual conference saw participation from over 200 representatives, including project partners from 13 countries. Distinguished speakers addressed a wide range of topics related to climate change.

Training on "Climate Change, Renewable Energy"

Staff members of Khazar University - Rovshan Abbasov, Head of the Department of Geography and Environment and Rovshan Karimov served as trainers during a program on "Climate Change and Renewable Energy." This training was organized by the Environmental Research Center of Khazar University in collaboration with the Baku Higher Oil School and took place from January 14 to 19, 2022. The program drew participants from various ministries, companies, and universities. It

focused on exploring the future of solar, wind, geothermal, green hydrogen energy, and their potential applications in Azerbaijan.



SDG 14 Life below water

Preventing plastic pollution through the campus's waste management policy

Khazar University is dedicated to reducing plastic pollution in the Caspian Sea through its "zero waste-to-landfill" policy. This commitment will be realized by

reducing the usage of unnecessary single-use plastic items and disposables on its campuses.

Revision of sustainable development strategies of sturgeon in the Caspian Sea

In June 2022, the faculty staff of Khazar University's Department of Life Sciences conducted a visit to an azfish farm to evaluate the current condition of sturgeon populations. The goal is to encourage stakeholders from the region to collaborate and adopt sustainable development policies to safeguard the vulnerable sturgeon populations in the Caspian Sea. This strategy adjustment is a crucial measure to ensure the long-term survival of sturgeons and preserve the Caspian Sea ecosystem. Additionally, collaboration with national and international organizations is vital for the continued survival of this iconic and endangered fish species.



SDG 15 Life on land

Khazar University is dedicated to preserving its land through the implementation of policies focused on reducing plastic waste and safely disposing of hazardous waste.

Policy to Ensure that Food on Campus is Sustainably Farmed

In 2022, a policy was developed and approved to guarantee that food on campus is sustainably sourced. It serves as a framework to ensure that food and beverages are

produced, acquired, consumed, and disposed of in a manner that prioritizes environmental conservation, societal well-being, and animal welfare.

Soil Salinity seminar

In 2022, the Department of Life Sciences staff organized a seminar on soil salinity, an increasingly pervasive challenge in the realm of agriculture, that is adversely affecting crop yields and food security in various regions. These seminars are a platform to delve into the causes, consequences, and potential remedies for burgeoning issues.

The expert underscored the harmful impact of soil salinity on agricultural productivity, elucidating how it leads to diminished wheat crop yields and economic losses for farmers.

Curriculum
