

Khazar University's Sustainability Committee

Terms of Reference

Khazar University's Sustainability Committee aims to develop strategies that can help to promote sustainability academically, societally, and environmentally. In other words, increasing the quality of education, reducing inequalities in society, achieving economic growth, and protecting the natural resources and environment are encompassed within sustainability.

Education is considered the main medium to achieve sustainable development goals. The committee is responsible for developing the policy that can help to organize education responsive to sustainable development goals.

Responsibilities of the Committee within Sustainability

- Encouraging research, projects, and events within sustainability.
- Embedding sustainable development goals in university policies and activities (*e.g. student and staff recruitment, teacher pedagogy, curriculum design, learning, campus environment, facilities, and student and staff support services*).
- Raising staff and student awareness about SDGs and promoting their civic engagement within sustainability.
- Cooperating with secondary schools and other institutions for initiatives within sustainability.
- Creating an annual report describing the outcomes in the development of sustainability.

Membership

The committee comprises the chair, academic representatives (faculty members) and students. Students can be nominated by the Student Union or faculties. Nominated members are selected through the Committee Membership Selection Process.
